

**Qualifying Points (Riders):** MotoGP qualifying is divided into two sessions: Q1 and Q2. The top 10 riders from FP2 automatically advance to Q2, while the remaining riders, compete in Q1. At the end of Q1, the two fastest riders move on to Q2, while the rest are assigned grid positions from P13 onwards based on their lap times. Q2 then determines the final starting order for the top 12 positions, with the fastest rider securing pole position.

**Riders qualifying (1-12):** P1 - 12 points, P2 - 11pts, P3 - 10pts, P4 - 9pts, P5 - 8pts, P6 - 7pts, P7 - 6pts, P8 - 5pts, P9 - 4pts, P10 - 3pts, P11 - 2pts, P12 - 1 point

**No Time Set:** -10 points

**Disqualified:** -20 points

**Out-qualified your team-mate:** + 2 points

**Out-qualified by your team-mate:** - 2 points

**Reach Q2:** + 2 points

**Penalty (quali):** - 3 points/5-place grid penalty

**LCR Honda/Honda HRC/Yamaha/Trackhouse riders qualifying in the top 10:** +5 points

(Performance bonus)

**LCR Honda/Honda HRC/Yamaha/Trackhouse riders qualifying in the top 5:** +10 points

(Performance bonus)

**Pole rider smashing quali lap record:** +5 points

**Outqualifying all factory bikes of the same constructor -** +5 points

**Top speed (Quali - Top 5):** 1st - 5pts, 2nd - 4pts, 3rd - 3 pts, 4th - 2 pts and 5th - 1 point.

**Note:** If 2 riders have the same top speed, the rider who has qualified higher will be placed higher

**Qualifying Points (Teams):** Teams will score the combined points scored by the two riders (real-world riders) of the team in qualifying as mentioned above. In addition, they will score more as follows.

**Neither rider reaches Q2:** - 3 points

**One rider reaches Q2:** + 3 points

**Both riders reach Q2:** + 5 points

**Front-row start for both riders:** + 7 points

**Front-row (1-2) start:** +10 points

**1 rider beating all factory bikes (of the same constructor): +7 points**  
**Both riders beat all factory bikes (of the same constructor): +15 points**  
**Top speed (quali): +5 points**

### **Race Points (Riders):**

**Riders Race results (1-22):** P1 - 25 points, P2 - 21pts, P3 - 20pts, P4 - 19pts, P5 - 18pts, P6 - 17pts, P7 - 16pts, P8 - 15pts, P9 - 14pts, P10 - 13pts, P11 - 12pts, P12 - 11pts, P13 - 10pts, P14 - 9pts, P15 - 8pts, P16 - 7pts, P17 - 6pts, P18 - 5pts, P19 - 4pts, P20 - 3pts, P21 - 2pts, P22 and further - 1 point

**1-2 finish (race): +10 points**

**Positions Gained: +1 point/position**

### Prediction Challenge 2 Points:

Question - Predict the fastest lap (FL) of the race.

(minute) : (second) . (millisecond) (millisecond) (millisecond)

Example - Predict the fastest lap of the race for the Thai GP. Grid Master will provide the fastest lap data for the previous 3 races.

Suppose your answer is 1:29.450

And the actual FL is 1:29.575

Grid Master will compute the difference (regardless of positive or negative) between the actual FL and your answer. In this case, this difference is **0.125**

This difference will be **subtracted** from your final team score.

Hence, your final score will be

(turbo-rider points) + (non turbo-rider points) + (team points) + (prediction challenge 1 points - range specific question, if any) - (prediction challenge 2 points - fastest lap)

Assuming your final score was 250 points before the fastest lap computation, your final score now will be

250-0.125  
= 249.875

This prediction challenge adds more excitement and acts as an excellent tie-breaker.

**Note:** In a rare scenario where the teams are tied, the team that was created earlier will finish higher.
